<b>Chemistry profile and complete blood count (CBC)</b> A blood chemistry profile, including SDMA, provides information about your dog's kidneys, liver, and pancreas, as well as other functions of the body, such as blood sugar and hydration. <b>Complete urinalysis</b> This analysis assesses the overall health of your dog's urinary tract, including the kidneys and bladder. <b>Intestinal Parasite Test</b> This test checks for intestinal parasites that may live in your dog's gastrointestinal tract.
